

Camping ABC
7th Firebirds Festival at Trebsen Castle and Trebsen Park
from June 28^h 2017 to July 1th 2018

Check in: earliest Thursday, June 28^h 2018 from 6 p.m.
Check out: latest Monday, July 2nd 2018 till 12 a.m.

During those times the campsite will be open round the clock.

At the arrival every guests with a camping ticket will get a wristband, which entitles to enter the campsite. Furthermore each guest receives a garbage bag for a responsible waste disposal at the set- aside containers. Bulky waste objects like sofas or else will not be authorized for the campsite.

First

The castle grounds are an official monument, which the city of Trebsen kindly lets us have as a campsite. Please leave it the way you found it.

As well as the last years, there will be no separate electricity. We checked the possibilities for electricity for each camper. This would have led to a duplication of the costs, that's why we choose not do so in interest of your costs. **Thanks for your understanding!**

Camping

The car park for campers will be within walking distance behind the campsite.

With the help of a pull-along wagon or a handcart you can bring you equipment from the car park to the campsite. But you have to do this with muscle strength and per hand. This applies to you arrival and departure.

The content of you equipment will be checked, with that we are making sure nothing unauthorized or dangerous will be brought to the campsite.

Important: On the campsite trailers are not permitted.

Permitted are tents and camping material, the usual camping equipment and common camping utensils. A pavilion with 3x3 meters will not be a problem.

Superstructures like greater tents of the Bundeswehr or the DRK are not allowed. Also you are not allowed to compile a ditch or else.

Camper/ car sleeper

Camper have to be parked at the at the acknowledged set-up area.

What counts as a Camper?

Camper: is a vehicle with the amount of the fellow passengers and equally amount of permanent crash pads.

Trailer: is an authorized vehicle for public streets, with the amount of the fellow passengers and equally amount of permanent crash pads. It is allowed to use one awning or pavilion.

Further tents for more places to sleep are not allowed.

Fire/ Barbecue

Open fire is strictly prohibited. Barbecuing with commercially available devices is permitted.

Please note a sufficient distance to inflammable objects like tents or campers within barbecuing. We reserve us the right to change this permission by misuse of gas cartridges or grills

Please don't cook inside of your tents und keep a sufficient distance to nearby tents. Please have a bucket of water to extinguish in emergencies.

Don't risk your life or the life of others.

There has to be a lane for emergency vehicles at all useable areas in a sufficient width. Each violation will be punished with a charge and the immediate reprimand of the campsite and festival.

We act in interest of everybody's safety and thank you for support.

FAQs

Can I camp, if I have a day ticket?

As far as there is still a capacity it's valid:

Of course every owner of a day ticket can camp at the festival weekend. A camping ticket will be 25,00€ in advanced sale and 29,00€ at evening box-office, valid per person and from Friday until Monday – with-it it doesn't matter if you stay for one or three days. Even if you arrive on Saturday and just want to stay for one night, the amount has to be paid

Will there be power connectors and mains hose?

There will no special power connectors or mains hose. But there will be sufficient WC, Showers and drinking water.

If my friends arrive earlier, may I still camp with them?

This is just possible if you friends build you tent. Keeping space clear or reserve certain places is not permitted. If you're coming late, you have to expect some limits.

A part of the group arrives by trailer, the other by car. May we still camp together?

This year groups with tents, trailers and car sleepers will be allowed. Conditions are that cars and trailers will not be moved because of potential risk of accidents.

Refrigerators/ generators are not permitted.

Camping breakfast

On Saturday and Sunday will be a delicious breakfast offer at Trebsen castle with fresh coffee from 10 a.m.

Left old sofas, armchairs, building material etc cause major problems and costs for waste disposal. That's why bringing those objects is strictly forbidden. Vehicles and trailers loaded with bulky waste or furniture will not get on the car park.

Animals/ pets

Please leave your pets at home. At the campsite they will be exposed by noise and stress and aren't in good keeping.
